October 16th 1745
 Jacobus Demirants Ear Mark is a Cropp of the End
 of the Left Ear & a Slit in the End of the same Ear
 & near the Middle of the Ear

November 28th 1745
 Elisha Babcock Senior & Elisha Babcock Junior
 Ear Mark is a Cropp off the Right Ear; a Slit in the
 End of the Left Ear & a half Penny in the Back side of same
 Ear - their Brand is B on the Right ^{thigh} Right Shoulder

John Timbrey Ear mark is a slit in the End of
 the Right Ear & two slits in the End of the Left
