

To the Surveyors for Laying out A high way or Road
 Orange County memorandom made the Seventh Day of August
 1752 That we whose Names are under written freeholders of
 the Said neighbourhood in the precinct of Hanoverstrans
 are willing and Desire and we do mutually agree and it is
 agreed to have a high way or publick Road Surveyed and Laid
 out by the Surveyors Chosen and appointed by Virtue of and
 Act made for that that purpose or the major part of them two
 Rods wide the trees to be marked ^{with} a Splice and three Nicks under
 it by the Surveyors the above Said or by there orders for Laying
 out high ways or publick Roads to begin on the East Side of
 the Demerres Kill at a Bridge known by the name of the Engles
 English bridge from thence Running Easterly to the Kings high
 way or Road and one other high way or publick Road of two
 Rods wide Surveyed and Laid out to begin on the East Side of the
 Kings Road above Said to begin at a place known by the name of
 Peter Geselar bridge to be Surveyed and Laid out in manner as
 the above Said Road as the Road now runs to or till it comes to
 the house of Ari or Lambirt Smith the Last Road allowed to
 hang good Easy Swinging gates
