 whole Road to Run on of S. willson's Land until it meet
 with David Hallsteads Land then through the S. Hallsteads
 Land until it meets with the Main Road on the line betw
 him and Jacob Arden the whole Road on S. Hallsteads
 Land to be two Rods wide - Laid out by us Commissioners
 of the Highways
