and a Cross the Land of Benjamin Knapp on the west side of
of the same swamp, Untill it Coms to the house of the said
Benjamin Knapp or near by and from thence Running
Westerly a Cross the Land of the Benjman to a white oak
tree near the a swamp marked on two firs, a little three haches so
Running north by on the East side of the swamp, a the trees are
marked Untill it Coms to a small Brook on the Land of
Garrat Garrison and so Running a Cross the Land of the said
Garrison a the trees are marked and so Running north by a
Cross the other Land, Untill it Coms near to the house where
Benjamin yoman, near Livoth of the government which
Jonathan yoman bought of the said yoman to a tree white
oak marked and from thence Running Westerly a Long the

tree and so Running to the mountain this Road is to be three
Rods wide and Layd out By We the Commissioners of the High
