York to me in hand paid by Jonathan Lounsbury and John
Snyder Both of the presinct of Harverstraw County of ora
and province of new York Boatmen whereof I do acknowledge
the Receipt and myself therewith fully satisfied Contented and
paid have Bargained Sole set over and Delivered and by these
presents do Bargain Sell Convey and Confirm unto the
Jonathan Lounsbury and Johannes Snyder all that good
Hoop or Vefall called the New Bourough with all her
Masts and Rigging and all other appurtenances to her
Belonging as also Sixty acres of Cedar Swamp Lying and
Being on the North Side of Landing Creek about 2 mile
