

Orange Haverstraw Precinct October the 28th 1770
 County then we the Commissioners of the high ways, laid
 a Road, beginning by the Road, that leads through the Manors
 of Bogard, to Orange Town, by a Tree marked on the North
 side of said road, and so running Northwardly by the marked
 Trees, on the East side of said Trees, until it comes to an
 old Path, along the said Path, till it comes to the foot of a
 Hill, to the Southward of Wouter's Van Orden's house
 and so Northwardly through his Orchard up the Hill until
 it comes to a Fens, then across the fence running West-
 wardly, to an old path, to a certain white oak Tree marked
 then Northwardly, as the Trees are marked, along the
 East side of the marked trees, until it comes to the
 Land of Jacob Archer, then Westwardly between the said
 Archer and John Halstead till it comes to a Swamp,
 then Northwardly along the Swamps, so near as the ground
 is good for a Road, and as the Trees are marked for
 the west side of the road, and so continue till it comes
 to the Land of Petrus Van Houten, on the division
 line of Cairat Patten, this road lies out two Rods
 wide.
