meets the Land of Derrick Straat and then Eastward
on the Land of sd. Straat until it comes to the Land
of Stephen Gornee and then between Stephen Gornee
and Johannis Jurry until it comes to a certain
Swamp or Pond and then round the sd. Pond on the side
Jurrys Land on dry ground until it comes to the
again between the sd. Gornee and sd. Jurry, until it
meets the Road that leads to Orange Town, the
whole laid out two Rods wide by us
