

September 24th 1713 it being Assented by twelve
 freeholders that it was Absolutely necessary to alter the Road that
 Leads from Coopers Sawmill Across Lowrance Van Buskirk's mill
 Pond & was also Judged necessary by the Commissioners whose names
 are here Under. Mentioned, in Lieu of which we the Commissioners
 Laid Out a Road: Beginning at the Road near Coopers Sawmill
 on the Bank, the west side of the Creek, from thence Easterly
 Across the Creek & Along the Dam of the Sawmill, as near the
 Dam as convenient, to the foot of the Ridge, from thence Nor-
 therly along the foot of the Ridge as near the foot of the Ridge
 as convenient, for the Road; untill it Intersects the Old Road
 & from the said Road westerly to Lowrance Van Buskirk's
 Mill, & as near the Mill Pond as the Land will admit of
 for a good Road - A Road Laid two Rods wide by us
