 Lord one thousand seven hundred and sixty one
 Whereas the above bounden persons Coslar and Abermann Coslar
 Coslar Vri Coslar by a certain Indenture of Release maid
 and Executed Under the hands and seals of Peter Coslar and
 Anakoy his wife Baring Date the Eight Day of June in the year
 of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and fifty three and
 among other things there in Mentioned to be Bargained and sold
 and the said peter Coslar and Anakoy his wife Did Grant and
 Conuay unto the sd John Ryden the hals of two hundred and
 thirty seven acres of Land situated Lying and Being in the
 princt of hauesstrom and County of orange and prouince of New
 York bounded on East by Garrit mine and philip serusit and
 on the south by Abraham godding on the West by Henry myter
 on the North by the said John Ryden and James Ransom of By
 the said Deed Being had it well all Large appear with the said
 Bound Lot or two hundred and thirty seven acres of Land and the
 said perelus Coslar Abermann Coslar and Vri Coslar and the
 said John Ryden agreed in opinion to be of the worth or Value of
 the sum of three hundred and sixty seven pounds Current
