Orange June of 1771 there was a Road laid out by us the
County under mentioned Commissioners for William Sloe to
his house upon the Land of Joseph Allison beginning at a
Stake mark by the fence of said Joseph Allison on a
Ground to the Northward of a small brook running into a
meadow of John Deroyelles Esq and then South Easterly to a Chestnut
tree about nine chains or a half then southerly along
the upland on the East side of the said meadow to the Eastward
of the burning place and then southerly to a Chestnut Sapling
and to the Land of the said William Sloe about eight chains
the Road to be twenty foot in breadth on the Eastward
of the above mentioned line
