 for myself my heirs &c^{ts} & Administr^{rs} do Covenant and
 Agree to and with the above named Garret myer his &c^{ts}
 Administr^{rs} and Assigns to warrant and Defend the Sale of the
 above named Stallion and Goods aforesaid Against all Persons
