 Crowders Land till it meets with the Land of the heirs of Mr  
 Oglesbee whereon Jacob Eckerson & John Eckerson now lives  
 said Course across said Land till it Comes to the Local Bridge  
 from the first Mentioned Place to this Bridge this Road to  
 bee as the Old Road now Goes & from said Bridge, & from  
 said Bridge a Straite Course to Peter Vanhouters South west  
 Corner from thence northerly Between said Peter Vanhouter  
 & Colo<sup>ne</sup> W<sup>m</sup> Bayard untill it meets with the Land of Abram  
 Servent then westerly Between S<sup>r</sup> Bayard & Servent  
 till it Comes to Servents South west Corner from thence  
 northerly Between said Bayard & Servent till it meets  
 with a Road that Leads from Orange town towards John  
 woods tree the whole of this Road to be two Rods wide
