 to Junius Cuyper for y<sup>e</sup> sum of Twenty five Pounds in which Bill of Sale  
 said Coost doth Over & Deliver unto y<sup>e</sup> said Junius Cuyper One certain  
 Crop of wheat & Rye now in y<sup>e</sup> Parricks one certain Brown Mair of y<sup>e</sup> age of  
 fifteen years One certain sorrel Mair of y<sup>e</sup> age of five years One certain Red  
 Cow with a white head One Other Spotted Red and white Cow & one Other Black  
 Cow with a white spot in y<sup>e</sup> forehead One heifer streaked Red and white One  
 Other heifer with a white streak Over her back One Bye Steer calf one Brown  
 Steer calf with a white face one Brown heifer calf as also Six Swine one  
 Ram of sheep also One feather Bed One Cradle and one Christ one small Cup  
 board two Iron Potts one Pair of hand Irons two Trammels one Cradle one  
 Churn one Saddle and Bridle Eight Pewter Plates & one Pewter Blatter  
 To have and to hold to the said Junius Cuyper his heirs & Assigns  
 as signs &c Given y<sup>e</sup> 11<sup>th</sup> of December 1772

December 14<sup>th</sup> 1772 Orange County and Bro

Orange County November 20<sup>th</sup> 1775 - A Road laid Out by the Commis  
 sioners of y<sup>e</sup> Precinct of Harver, Straub, W<sup>h</sup>, John Coe and  
 Junius Cuyper Esq; beginning on the highway line on a Road leading  
 from Garamus to Cahatts upon the land of Samuel Bontar, from thence  
 northerly across the land of said Bontar, till it meets with the land of  
 David P. Ackerman, said course across said Ackermans Land untill it  
 meets with the land of John Bush & across S<sup>h</sup> Bushes Land till it comes  
 to the north west corner of Peter Ackersons Lott & then continuing the  
 same course between John Bush & Antony Crowter till it comes to  
 the north east corner of said Bushes Land said course across Antony  
 Crowters Land till it meets with the land of the heirs of Mr. Ogelsbee  
 whereon Jacob Ackerson & John Ackerson now lives, said course across  
 Land till it comes to the Local Bridge from the first mentioned place  
 to this Bridge this Road to go as the Old Road now goes, & from said  
 Bridge a Strait course to Peter Van Houtens South west corner, from  
 thence northerly between said Peter Van Houten & Calomb W<sup>h</sup>, Bayard  
 untill it meets with the land of Abraham Servent then westerly  
 between said Bayard & Servent till it comes to Servents South west  
 corner from thence northerly between S<sup>h</sup> Bayard & Servent till  
 it meets with a Road that leads from Orange Town towards  
 John woods tree the whole of this Road to be two Rods  
 wide Laid - By
