 Fredericks opposite A Large Creek in said Fredericks
 Land from thence south east as their about to say Creek and
 near the Old Road, across the Creek from thence as the Road
 now goes to the foot of the hill & from thence up S. hill
 to the South & to the north to the best advantage to the top
 of said, then Easterly as the Road now goes, to the Eastward
 of Hendrick Wanamakers house, then north east as the
 trees are marked till it comes to the Land of Andries Pells
 Velt then along the line upon the Land of Andries Pells
 Velt till it comes to the Land of Michael Crawbock the along
 the line of Hendrick Wanamaker, But on said Crawbocks
 Land till it meets with the Land of Lodewick Shoemaker
 thence Easterly Between S. Shoemaker & Crawbock
 till it meets with the Land of Adam Daitje then northerly
 Between S. Daitje & Crawbock to a white Oak Sapling
 Marked, from thence a Direct Course across S. Daitjes
 Land Land nearly north east to the top of the hill to a
 Chesnut Sapling Marked from thence Easterly upon
 a Lot in the Possession of Richard Osborn and
 Samuel Sixcoat, till it comes to the line of Richard
 Osborn to a white Oak Sapling marked near the South
 end of the Lane then northerly ill an East Course
 Bears Between the house and Barn of Richard Osborn
 to the Road upon the west end of the Lot of Johannes
 Young, this Road laid out two Rods in Breadth by
 us two of the Commissioners for the Precinct of
 Hammerstraw
