in Compliance with a petition of John gutches
 And others in the town of harvestraue Circuit
 in Said the Commissioners of the highways in Said
 Met on monday the twenty eighth instant according to the
 Prayer of Said petition and laid out the Road as follows
 viz. We began at place where the above road enters the road
 leading from Kings ferry to Morris town by the corner
 John Suffern Esqr now swells from thence easterly with
 a direct line to the brook passing in front of the House
 And to the Southward of the brew House where Mr Daniel
 grows lives crossing said brook to easterly of near where we
 marked with a blaze and two notches as the ground will
 admit and where the old road runs to the lot or line of said
 Sufferns messanities to thence as it is marked easterly
 through Said lot to a large white oak tree marked as
 aforesaid easterly as near the woods and marks as aforesaid
 as the ground possibly will admit to a peach tree to the
 South of the House from thence easterly as marked to
 the place where it enters the old road near philip foxs line
 thence as the old road now goes to the woods or chestnut
 marked thence through Said woods easterly as near as the
 ground will admit to that piece of road passing the north
 end of Mathers barbars House thence to the saddle river road
 along said road to the house of Derick warramaker thence easterly
 to the South side of said warramakers woods and marks as aforesaid
 to the corner of lines of John gutches and Cornelius Smith and so
 between said lines to ^{the} east side of the Swamp to the South east of
 Said gutches line from thence as near said line easterly as the ground
 will admit to the west side of an other Swamp marked as aforesaid
 Said thence as it is marked along the said west side of said swamp
 to its head thence easterly as it is marked to the old road commonly called
 the Iron Road thence easterly along a road to the road leading from Col. Gilbert
 Supers to parsons along said road to the House of Elizabeth Jagers thence
