 Bargained premises unto the said James Sharp his Executors and  
 Administrators and assignors to the only proper use and behoof  
 of him the said James Sharp his Executors Administrators  
 & assignors forever & I the said Abraham Thomas for  
 myself my Executors & Administrators the said  
 Bargained premises unto the said James Sharp  
 his Executors Administrators & assignors against all &  
 all manner of persons shall & will warrant & never  
 defend by these presents in witness whereof together with  
 the Delivery of the said bargained premises I have here  
 unto set my hand & seal this Twentieth Day of March  
 & in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred &  
 Eighty two
