

160 Know all men by these presents that I Abraham Polhemus of Haverstraw precinct in the County of Orange & State of New York Yeoman for & in Consideration of the sum of one note of hand given the first Day of February 1772 of 16 pound & 2 Shillings with lawfull Interest to me in hand Paid by James Sharp at the Involving & Delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained & sold & by these presents doth fully & clearly Grant bargain & sell & Release unto the said James Sharp of the said precinct of Haverstraw aforesaid one Gray horse Commencing three years & one Sould horse with sole Eye to have & to hold the said two horses unto the James Sharp his Executors Administrators & Assignes & the Abraham Polhemus for myself my heirs Executors & Administrators waivent the Sale of the above two horses unto the said James Sharp his heirs & Assignes against the Claim & Demand of any other Person whatsoever provided always that if the said Abraham Polhemus his Executors or Administrators well & Truly Pay or cause to be paid unto the said James Sharp his heirs or Assignes the above sum of 16 pounds & 2 Shillings with the Interest from the Date hereof on or before first Day of May next without fail or any Delay then this present Bill of Sale to be void & of none Effect or otherwise to be & Remain in full force & virtue in witness whereof I the said Abraham Polhemus have here unto set my hand & seal the twenty first Day of February & in the year of our Lord one Thousand seven Hundred & Eighty Two
