

New Milbrim 24th May 1702

At a meeting of the Commissioners of the Highways for the
 Precinct of Haverstham at John Jeffers on a Survey
 of the Road from the House of the said John Jeffers to the
 Precinct Line between Stephen Stettin and widow Johnson
 in the Grove it appeared to us that the said road is in
 the very best place and convenientest Ground where
 it now runs that is to say from John Jeffers by
 to the Edge of the mountains thence along the said
 Mountains Edge as near as is convenient to where
 the former Bridge Crossed the Dam a pough then
 Pass'd the Black Horse Thence with its former Course
 to the above mentioned line in the said Grove &
 from the Corner by the said John Jeffers South
 between the lines of the farm now in the tenure
 of Capt. Daniel Green & the farm of John Jeffers
 Northward of said neck & adjoyns Wainmakers to
 where the said line strikes the Jersey line
 and from the Corner where the said John Jeffers line
 Northwesterly along where the former Road was
 laid out when in the Jersey to the Creek where
 the old Jersey line formerly intersected the said
 Road on the Road to Haverstham at Landing or
 Harriet
