A Return of a Road laid out by the Commissioners
of the High ways for the precinct of Haverhill
According to the prayer of forty one freeholders & Inhabit-
ants of said precinct - & beginning at the end of a lane
leading from the Corner near Mr. Abraham Blauvelt
& a long said lane Eastward of a large tree & south of
the House & Barn of Reynard House & a stone set up in
the field of said house from thence Southwardly to
the Corner of said field & Enters said Lane Along said
Lane Westwardly a few Rods to or Near a swamp thence
Crosses the fence to the East side of said swamp Southwardly
by along said swamp as near said swamp as the Ground
will admit to a tree marked and to the Eastward of said tree
thence Southwardly to the line of Major John Smith from thence
across said Smiths yard to a cross fence in said Smiths yard
from thence along the west side of said fence to the land in
the possession of Hindauck Andurdonek to a tree marked
thence Southwardly along a swamp in the Old Road or
as near as the Ground will admit for a good Road to
the Land of Thomas Blauvelt thence as near as
Dunst line as the Ground will admit Southwardly to
a cross said Blauvelts lands to the Eastward of a white
wood tree standing in the line of Adrian Andurdonek
Or to the End of the Road there said Out
