

Know all men by these presents that I Aaron Star of Harris town precinct orange County State of New York hath bargained and sold and doth by these presents bargain and sell unto Andrew Thompson for and in consideration of the sum of five pounds nineteen shillings and five pence current lawfull money of New York state the receipt whereof is Acknowledged two ~~mares~~ mares one a black one the other a black with a Star like a half moon in her forehead and a Cow a black one all now in possession of the said Aaron Star to have and to hold said two mares and Cow hereby sold against the claim or claims of any person or persons whatsoever which said two mares & Cow the said Aaron Star doth put the said Andrew Thompson in full possession of before the signing and sealing hereof it is further agreed that the said Star hath equity of Redemption untill the first day of June next ensuing the date hereof provided he the said Star pay the above said sum of five pounds nineteen shillings & five pence with lawfull Interest from the date untill paid at said period in witness whereof I the said Aaron Star doth hereunto set my hand and seal this 10th day January 1785
