before the Ensealing and Delivery of these presents by John Vorhis and Garret Eckerson the receipt whereof I do hereby Acknowledge have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain and sell unto the said John Vorhis and Garret Eckerson three Cows their Colour one and the second a brown and the third a brindle likewise two Horses their Colour on a dark brown of a mare of a sorrel Colour and five sheep to have and to hold said bargained and sold premises by these presents unto the said John Vorhis and Garret Eckerson their Executors Administrators and assigns forever and I the said James Springsteen for myself my Heirs Executors and Administrators shall and will warrant and defend said Cattle Horses and sheep aforesaid by these presents unto the said Vorhis and Eckerson their Heirs Executors Administrators or assigns all of which creatures I the said James Springsteen have put the said John Vorhis and Garret Eckerson in full possession of at the sealing and signing thereof by Delivery one Cattle hat in witness whereof the said James Springsteen hath hereunto set his hand and seal this fifth day of April in the Year one thousand seven hundred and Eighty five
