 the old Brown Horse aforesaid - and I the Said Fredrick Youny for
 my self my Heirs Executors and Administrators the Said Bargained
 premises unto the Said John D Coe his heirs Executors Administrators
 of assigns against the Lawfull Claim of all Mannors of persons
 Shall and will Warrant and forever Defend by these presents -
 Nevertheless the Said Fredrick Youny hath Equity of Redemption untill
 the first Day of May which will be in the year one thousand Seven
 hundred and Eighty Six by paying the aforesaid Sum with such
