the said theodorus Smedeker and his heirs Executors and administrators  
will warrant and defend provided allways that if the said theodorus  
Smedeker or his heirs Executors or administrators shall well and  
truly say or cause to be said unto the said Johnnis Dewese the  
said sume of one hundred and sixty pounds on or before the first Day of  
may in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Eighty  
seven with any praid or Delay then this present bargain and sale to be  
void and of none effect ore else to stand remain in full force and virtue  
in witness whereof the said theodorus Smedeker hath here unto set his  
hand and seal the fourth Day of march in the year of our Lord one  
thousand seven hundred and Eighty Six
