

at the said meeting agreed that a house be built for the use of the poor of the precinct and to be built on the land belonging to the Courthouse in said precinct that Jacob Cole Esq be the person appointed to superintend the building of said house and to be enabled to receive the monies voted for that purpose and to be accountable for the Expenditure thereof of the monies received to the justices of the general Sessions of the Peace when there unto required that the sum of one hundred ~~and~~ fifty pounds be raised for the above purpose and for the support of the poor before and in the time of building and afterwards for their support

the Law passed by the People of the precinct in the year 1785 for preventing strangers coming in and forming a settlement in the precinct be continued voted in the affirmative

the Law respecting ^{negroes} ~~last~~ made for the precinct when the state of Newyork was a Colony be confirmed and be a Law of this precinct for the present year
