 assigns the above named Good Pittauger called the
 Polly Together with all the Sails Rigging ickling
 and masts Booms yards anchor Cables and sand
 Every thing that to the said Pittauger belongs in any
 wise appurtenant ^{and Jolly Boat} To Have and to Hold the said
 Pittauger and all and Every the appurtenances there-
 unto belonging and Jolly Boat unto the sd George
 Suffern and John Suffern their heirs Executors ^{ors} assigns
 and assigns To the Sole and only Proper use Benefit
