 Bargain and sell unto Johannis De Vries of the said Precinct Yeoman
 in plain and Open market One Black Horse Three milch
 Cows and One Two year Old Heifer Twenty One sheep six Hogs
 All my Household Furniture One Calc the Grain Growing
 and all the Farming utensils. To Have and to Hold the
 above Bargained Goods and Chattels unto the said Johannis De Vries
 His Heirs Executors Administrators and assigns forever
 Provided allways that if the said Abraham Colburn his
 Heirs Executors or Administrators Do pay or Cause to be
 Paid unto the said Johannis De Vries or assigns the just and
 true sum of Thirty pounds Fourteen shillings and six pence
 Together with Lawfull Interest On or before the second
 Tuesday in November next without any fraud or Delay then
 this Bill of sale to be void or else to remain in full force and
 Virtue the above mentioned Thirty pounds Fourteen shillings
 and six pence to be paid in silver and Gold in watre payment
 of the said Abraham Colburns hath hereunto set his
 Hand and seal this first day of June 1782
