 and in consideration of the Sum of Twelve pounds Current
 Lawfull money of New York in hand paid hath
 Bargained and sold unto Hendrick Onderdonk of the
 said precinct one sord gelding with a blaze and
 four white feet about nine years Old and one sord
 mare with a small wound in her side To Have
 To Hold the said mare and gelding unto him
 said Hendrick Onderdonk his heirs and assigns forever
 provided always that if the said Samuel Taylor or
 his Executors or administrators shall and do well
 truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said Hendrick
 Onderdonk his heirs or assigns the Just and full sum
 of Twelve pounds Current money aforesaid on
 Before the first Day of Octobr next ensuing the Date
 hereof Together with Lawfull Interest from the Date here
 then this Bill of Sale to be void In witness whereof
 the said Samuel Taylor hath hereunto set his hand
 and seal the fourth Day of January Anno Domini
 one Thousand Seven Hundred and Eighty five
