 Taylor of haverstraw precinct in the County of  
 orange state of New York for & in consideration of the  
 sum of fifteen pound nine shillings current lawfull  
 money of New York, in hand paid hath granted bargained  
 & sold unto Jonathan Taylor of the s<sup>d</sup> precinct one sorrel  
 mare with a birt upon her left side & a star in her fore-  
 head about six years old three hogs marked with a crop of  
 the right ear & a slit in the left together with all his house-  
 hold good to have & to hold the s<sup>d</sup> mare & hogs & household  
 goods unto him the s<sup>d</sup> Jonathan Taylor his heirs & assigns  
 forever provided always that if the s<sup>d</sup> Sam<sup>r</sup> Taylor or his  
 Executors or administrators shall and do well & truly pay or  
 cause to be paid unto the s<sup>d</sup> Jonathan Taylor his heirs or af-  
 signs the just & full sum of fifteen pound nine shillings  
 current money afores<sup>d</sup> on or before the first day of Janu-  
 ary next ensuing the date hereof for redemption of the  
 bargained premises then this Bill of sale to be void of none  
 effect but if default be made in the payment of the s<sup>d</sup> fif-  
 teen pound nine shillings in whole or in part contrary  
 to the manner & form afores<sup>d</sup> that then it shall remaine  
 & be in full force & virtue & draw Interest from the first  
 Day of January eighty seven in witness whereof I hereunto  
 set my hand & seal the fifth day of April Anno domini  
 1786 and Delivered
