presents according to the form of Law I bargain sell and
Deliver unto the said Abraham Jones one black horse about
thirteen hands and half high one sorrel mare about eight years
old with a cross in her forehead and gray main and tail
one two year old red heffer with white legs and belly
and crop off her rite ear to have and to hold the said
bargined premises unto the said Abraham Jones his Execu-
tors administrators and assigns for ever shall and will war-
ant and for ever Defend by these presents provided never-
the less that if of the said Stephen Taylor my heirs Executors
and administrators and assigns or any of us Do and shall
well and truly say or Cause to be said unto the said Ab-
raham Jones his Executors administrators the sum of ten
pounds gold or silver on the first Day of June next ensuing
from the Date here of for the redemption of the bargined
premises then this present bill of sale shall be void and of
none Effect but if Default be made in the payment of
the said ten pounds in part or in the whole Contrary to
the manner and forme aforesaid that then it shall remain
in full force and virtue in witness whereof of have hereunto
set my hand and seal this third Day of February in the year
of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Eighty six.
