

I know all men by these presents that of Isaac Parker
of hamiltons precinct County of orange and state of new
york yeoman for Divers good Causes and Considerations
me here unto moving and also in consequence of a certain
obligation by the said Isaac Parker aforesaid given to
walter Smith of the same place merchant in which
obligation I acknowledge my selfe to be justly Due
and owing the said walter Smith the sum of six pound
thirteen shillings and six pence current Lawfull money of N
york state to be paid in one week from the Date of said rentd
obligation which Date is 29th Day of august anno domini 1786 -
and on non payment of said sum I volenterly acknowledge that
said Smith should have his choice of two of my cows as value
for said sum of six pound thirteen shillings and six pence
as aforesaid referance to the same allowed and for as much as
said sum is not paid I hereby confirm said obligation by selling
him the said walter Smith two red cows marked with a hole
in each Ear and a Cropp in the off Ear one both Ends of Ears by
past each Cow white in the face one five year old past and
the other about eight past for this reason and that of the said
Isaac Parker for me my heirs Executors and admynes I ratore
shall and will warrant and always Defend the said walter
Smith his heirs Executors admynes ratore and assigns in the full
possession of said two cows against the Claim or Claims of any
person or persons whatsoever in the full sum of ten pounds
current money as aforesaid to be recovered of me by the s^r. Walter
Smith in a summary manner without fraud or deceit. I
father of the said Isaac Parker do put the s^r. Walter Smith in
full possession of said two cows as his own propriety them to hold
in his own Right. as Witness my hand & seal this eighth
day of February in the year one Thousand seven hundred eighty
& seven..
