a white Hair Marked with a Slit in y^e End of each Ear the other
a sucking colt of said Hair of Black Colour

November of 18th 1772

One Stray Star Marked with a halfpenny y^e fore side of the off Ear & a
Slit y^e y^e same Ear & a Cropp of y^e End of y^e left Ear About five or
six years Old with a Bell Marked with y^e letter M. his Colour
Red with a streak over his back with some white under his belly

December of 30th 1772
One Stray heifer Marked with a Cropp of the End of the Left Ear
One Year Old East a Red with white under her belly her hind
Legs white By Johannes Geury

January of 5th 1774 A Stray Hair Colt in Pound at
Daniel Coe without Mark or Brand Either one or two Years
Old a Black with a Star in her forehead

March of 21st 1775 was Entered

A Stray Sheep a weather Marked with a Slit in the End of
each Ear a White one By Uldrick Bruce

April of 19th 1775

A Stray Hair taken up by Guisbert Johnson for her Colour
known with a small Star in her forehead neither Marked nor
branded that can be discovered

July of 21st 1775

A Stray Cow at Stevanos Stevenson on Wellfleet Island
A known Cow with a white streak on her back and a
speckled face Marked on the left Ear with a Cropp &
two Halfpennys under the same Ear

September 7th 1778 Set up at Publick Vendue
By Jaramiah Fowler a Stray horse being Duly
Advertised in the Publick Print and Brought
to the highest Bidder Jaramiah Fowler for Twenty
four Shillings By me Eben^r Wood Vendue master
St. Wood Town
